In a recent study, researchers determined that the physical exam doubled the diagnostic power of the history by 19.5% to 39%, while the addition of basic diagnostic studies increased diagnostic accuracy by another 33%. 11 In this particular study, 90% of accurate diagnoses were determined through the history, physical exam, and selective studies either alone or in combination. 11 Therefore, by basing the diagnostic workup on the specific information generated through the history and physical ...
