Smoking is one of the most important risk factors behind disk herniation. Lumbar disk herniation may result from chronic coughing and other stresses on the disk. For example, sitting without lumbar support causes an increase in disk pressures, and driving is also a risk factor because of the resonant coupling of 5-Hz vibrations from the road to the spine.

Herniated Nucleus Pulposus: Background, Anatomy ...

The most common cause of lumbosacral radiculopathy is a herniated disc or degenerative arthritis leading to stenosis of the neural foramina. Other causes of radiculopathy include congenital abnormalities, infection, and cancer. Radiculopathy can occur at any nerve root, but L5 or S1 impairment is the most common.
